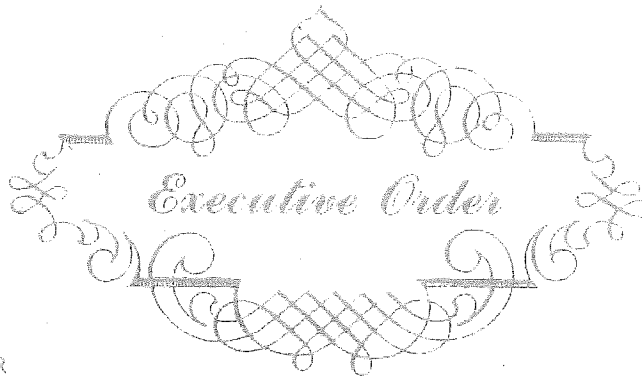

**AN ORDER TO RESCIND THE EXECUTIVE ORDER REGARDING THE MARIJUANA  
LEGALIZATION ACT**

**WHEREAS**, the 128<sup>th</sup> Maine Legislature has amended the Marijuana Legalization Act to assign substantial rulemaking, regulatory, and enforcement authority to the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the 128th Maine Legislature has appropriated funding to conduct the rulemaking necessary to implement the Act; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Paul R. LePage, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby order and direct as follows:

Executive Order 2017-002 is hereby rescinded.

This Executive Order is effective immediately upon signature.
